Position: Goal Umpires Development Coach / Observer

We are looking for a development coach to support the growth in our goal umpiring division in the Eastern Football League. This role would suit a senior umpire who would like to get involved in coaching & development.

Key functions/responsibilities in the role are:

- Conduct specific training drills to assist new & developing umpires with learning what is expected of them whilst carrying out their duties
- Liaise with the goal umpires coach to appoint goal umpires to all scheduled Division 1 U19s matches on a weekly basis throughout the season.
- Appoint goal umpires to our junior interleague & junior finals in liaison with the junior field head coach.
- Observe goal umpires in EFL matches played on a Saturday
- Make an appraisal of their standard of performance and their strengths and weaknesses
- Provide a written report of goal umpires (format provided) that assists the umpires' development and progression
- Ensure goal umpires are given background knowledge of the EFL and are informed of their obligations to the EFL and the umpiring group
- Attend AFL Victoria umpires seminar in early 2018.
- Attend monthly EFL umpires coaches' meetings

This position requires that you are available every Wednesday at our training venue from 5.15pm – 7.30pm.

Successful applicants must have:

- *Background in coaching*
- *strong communication and interpersonal skills*
- *Strong development focus*
- *strong organisational skills and attention to detail.*
- *basic computer skills*
- *level 1 or be willing to undertake a Level 1 Coaching Certificate*
