Position: Head Coach - Goal Umpiring

We are looking for a coach to head up our goal umpiring division in the Eastern Football League.

Key functions/responsibilities in the role are:

- Prepare a program and conduct coaching sessions on Wednesday nights (5.30pm) or have other coaches present those sessions.
- Conduct specific training drills to assist umpires with the learning what is expected of them whilst carrying out their duties
- Appoint goal umpires to all scheduled Senior and Division 1 Reserves & U19s matches on a
 weekly basis throughout the season and ensure they are entered Schedula by 12pm on the
 Tuesday prior to that weekends' matches
- Appoint goal umpires to our junior interleague & junior finals in liaison with the junior field head coach.
- Observe goal umpires in EFL matches played on a Saturday
- Make an appraisal of their standard of performance and their strengths and weaknesses
- Provide a written report of goal umpires (format provided) that assists the umpires' development and progression
- Ensure goal umpires are given background knowledge of the EFL and are informed of their obligations to the EFL and the umpiring group
- Liaise with the EFL administration, executive and club delegates
- Oversee the duties and responsibilities of goal umpires support staff
- Attend AFL Victoria umpires seminar in early 2018.
- Attend monthly EFL umpires coaches meetings

- Strong development focus
- strong organisational skills and attention to detail.
