

CLUB INFORMATION SHEET

Introduction

The main EFNL competition has been running for 9 seasons and continues to grow from strength to strength. 115 registered teams in 2024.

The Competition

- Netball is played on Friday nights
- November 1, 2024, through to February 28, 2025
- 12 week home and away season (14 weeks incl finals series)
- Finals format top 4, 2-week final 1 v 4, 2 v 3
- 2 time slots a night, with games scheduled from 6:45pm onwards
- Players must be turning 15 during the season to be registered to play
- Maximum of 2 teams per club

Venues

The Summer competition is played out of centralised uncovered courts:

- Pinks Reserve, Kilsyth
- Sportlink, Vermont South

Registration and Fees

Registration is in two parts:

- 1. GameDay Player registration
- 2. Netball Connect Netball Victoria 2025 Membership registration and payment

Both forms must be completed to be eligible to play for your club. All players must purchase a 2025 Netball Victoria Membership to take the court. This will carry over into the main 2025 EFNL Netball Season. Please note payment for this is required on the Netball Connect Registration Form. If you have already paid to another Netball Association for 2025 you will not be charged again.

Clubs are required to pay a registration fee for each team submitted to the competition. This fee assists to cover the operational costs of the competition such as court hire and umpires.

2024/25 Summer Registration fee - \$1190.00 per team

*There are no weekly court fees or entry fees at each venue.

Netball Victoria Membership

EFNL is an affiliated league of Netball Victoria, therefore ALL players are required to have a Netball Victoria Membership to take part in the competition

2025 Netball Victoria membership fees are as below:

Senior \$90.00

(players, umpires, coaches and bench officials born on or before 31/12/2007 - 18 years and over)

Junior \$70.00

(players, umpires, coaches and bench officials born between 1/1/2008 – 31/12/2018 – 7-17 years)

Off the Court \$56.00

(committee members, administrators, volunteers, parents and spectators)

Please note that these prices are subject to change following the update from Netball Victoria.

Insurance

Players are covered by insurance through their Netball Victoria Membership. Any injury claims need to be made through Netball Victoria.

Umpires

Umpires are provided by the league. The league is responsible for umpire development and allocations.

We are always looking to expand our umpire pool so if you or anyone you know is interested in umpiring, please contact the league.

Uniform

In accordance with the competitions' rules and regulations, all players must be in the same uniform to take the court. This can be official uniform or players may wear matching-coloured skirts/shorts and tops in club colours or just black for example.

Any official uniforms must be ordered through the leagues licensed suppliers.

Uniforms can include sponsors logo in accordance with the guidelines set out in the leagues By Laws. All uniform designs must be submitted to the Netball Manager and approved by the League prior to manufacture.
